1. SYNOPSIS

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How real is our individually perceived reality and what relevance does this question have within the make-up of our collective social structures?

This film accompanies the 'homeless philosopher' and 'professed lunatic' Fritz Joachim Rudert (alias Leonardell) on his mission to release the mind-controlled masses from their mania. And indeed it may appear that 'crazy' Fritz and his confederates from the German anti-phsychiatry movement "BPE" (Bundesverband gegen Psychiatrische Gewalt) achieved some political success.

The inquiries and works by renowned researchers - Allen Frances, Elisabeth Loftus, Joscha Bach and Gerhard Roth - exemplify the economic interests, scientific ambitions and political coherences in and around the world of the human consciousness.

"Anomaly" is an essayistic film about the systemic and individual 'abnormalities' of the so-called Western World. The result is a cinematic journey that provides an inventory of many fragmented and discursive narratives towards one singular conclusion: "Man is not worried by real problems so much as by his imagined anxieties about real problems" Epictetus

2. PRESSETEXT

"I would say that right now in the United States we are the worst place and the worst time to ever be severly mentally ill. I'm including the Middle Ages."

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More and more psychotropic drugs are coming to the market. At the same time, the number of mental illnesses continues to rise. How does that make sense? Are more and more people unable to cope with modern society? Or is it an industry that tries to maximize their profits?

The documentation "Anomalie" investigates in what society considers to be reasonable, normal or healthy. Ultimately, our view of what we consider "normal" expands.

Let's get closer to the topic from the outside: What if you consciously declare yourself to be insane? The homeless philosopher Fritz Joachim Rudert († 2017) was living out what it feels like to go through life apart from the norm.

He was an antipsychiatrist, a self-proclaimed scholar, and led a happy life as it seemed.

Complex economies work according to the principle of unified norms and units of measurement. Social agreements play an important role in social life. And in an increasingly short-lived world, the question of where mental health begins and ends ends up in ever-narrower bandwidths.

Behind the norm against which Fritz Joachim Rudert acted is no less than compatibility with the social whole. Renowned researchers such as Allen Frances (Journal of Personality Disorder), Elisabeth Loftus (University of California), Adelheid Kastner (Kepler University Hospital) or Gerhard Roth (German brain researcher), explain what mental norms are in a world that is guided by economic interests to form.

Individual fates and collective neuroses, committed scientists and abstruse experiments: who is normal?
